
#### **Internal Control Mechanism**


- □ The expenditure of the different Districts are Audited by CAG's Empanelled Chartered Accountant at the end of the Financial Year.


### **Rural Sanitation coverage in the State**





#### **State Road Map for achievement Swachh Bharat**




